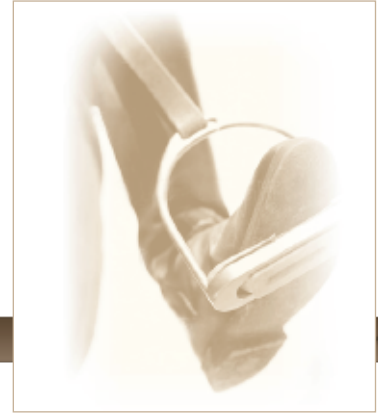


# guide to Horse Show Essentials what to pack



## WHAT TO TAKE IN YOUR GARMENT BAG

- Hair Ties, Nets, Brush, Pins, etc.
- Show Coats (navy or black go in any arena)
- Show Shirts with Collar (white is a safe bet)
- Show-quality Breeches (tan / white for Classics)
- Show Gloves (black)
- Show Belt (black or brown)
- Schooling Attire: Breeches, Shirt, Jacket
- Clean Boots
- Boot Socks
- Boot Polishing Kit
- Sunscreen, Sunglasses, Hat
- Sewing Kit

NOTE: While at the show grounds, your pre- and post-competition apparel must be neat and professional. Shirts must cover midriff and you must still have your feet in closed-toe shoes.

## WHAT TO PACK IN YOUR TACK TRUNK

(Please wash tack trunk covers and wipe down trunks. It goes without saying – but we're saying it anyway – that ALL items should be clean!)

- Embroidered Show Sheet
- Stable Blanket with Name
- Scrim Sheet with Name
- White Show Saddle Pads (that fit properly)
- Shipping Wraps:  
12"/14" for ponies, 14"/16" for horses
- Shipping Halter with Nameplate
- Bridle with Nameplate
- Martingale with Nameplate
- Girth with Nameplate
- Saddle with Nameplate
- Equitation/Jumping Boots for horse
- APPROVED Riding Helmet
- Helmet Liners
- Crop
- Spurs and Spur Straps
- Supplements
- Medications
- Paddock Boots
- Half Chaps
- Polo Wraps
- Checks (your trainer won't write checks for you)
- First Aid Kit
